***A critical element of professional policing is ensuring the response to resistance we use is appropriate, legal, within policy, reviewed for improvement and enhanced training and supervised. Below is an abbreviated summary of the instances of our response to resistance to arrest:**

Officers responded to a local apartment complex following a report of a domestic battery. After speaking with the victim, they established probable cause to arrest the suspect. While officers attempted to take the suspect into custody, he attempted to retreat further into his residence. Officers pursued and engaged the suspect, who actively resisted being handcuffed. To gain compliance, an officer displayed a Taser and issued verbal commands. The suspect ultimately complied and was secured without further incident. During the arrest, an uninvolved individual attempted to interfere. To prevent escalation and ensure the integrity of the arrest, an officer displayed a Taser and issued commands to this individual as well. Despite the warnings, the individual continued to interfere and was subsequently taken into custody. The suspect was arrested for Domestic Battery and Resisting a Peace Officer, while the interfering individual was charged with Obstructing a Peace Officer.

During a traffic stop, officers determined the passenger was wanted for two active felony warrants. Upon explaining he was under arrest, the subject refused to exit the vehicle. Officer displayed a Taser to him and he complied with their directions to exit the vehicle. He was transported back to the police department where he was booked and process. During his processing, the subject was allowed to use the phone but refused to give back the phone when he was done. Officers had to enter his cell to retrieve the phone. The subject threatened to fight with police officers. Again, he was shown a Taser and instructed to give back the phone to which he complied. As officers exited the cell, he attempted to exit the cell as well. An officer had to push him back into the cell in order to secure the door.

Officers stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation in the vicinity of State Route 161 and St. Clair Avenue. The driver was uncooperative and verbally stated he had ammunition in the car. For the safety of both individuals, the officer requested the driver step out of the vehicle. Once outside, the driver became physically combative with the officer. In response, a secondary officer unholstered a taser and pointed it at the driver, which immediately led to the driver complying with the officers' commands. The driver received citations for suspended registration and obstruction and was released from the stop.
