**\*A critical element of professional policing is ensuring the response to resistance we use is appropriate, legal, within policy, reviewed for improvement and enhanced training and supervised. Below is an abbreviated summary of the instances of our response to resistance to arrest:**

Officers working an additional security detail at St. Clair Square were informed a male subject, who had previously been issued a trespass notice by mall security, had returned to the property. The subject had been arrested multiple times for similar offenses. Upon locating the individual, officers made contact and advised him he was under arrest for criminal trespass. The subject was verbally defiant, stating he was not under arrest and refused to comply with officers' commands. In response, officers took hold of his arm and directed him to place his hands behind his back. During this interaction, the subject suddenly reached into his sweatshirt pocket. Officers executed a controlled takedown to prevent any escalation. Once on the ground, the subject was secured in handcuffs and taken into custody without further incident. No injuries.

Officers conducted a pedestrian check on a subject observed crossing State Route 161 in an unsafe/illegal manner. A routine records check revealed the individual had an active fugitive warrant. When officers attempted to take the subject into custody, he immediately fled on foot. In response, officers displayed their department-issued Taser devices but did not deploy them. After a brief pursuit, officers apprehended the subject and secured him in handcuffs without further incident. During the chase, the subject attempted to discard illegal narcotics, which were later recovered as evidence. He was taken into custody.

Officers responded to a report of a disturbance in which a subject was allegedly armed with a firearm and had made threats to shoot at police if they arrived. Upon locating the described vehicle, officers initiated a high-risk traffic stop to ensure the safety of all parties involved. Officers displayed their rifles and pistols while giving verbal commands for the occupants to exit the vehicle. Each subject was detained and secured in handcuffs without incident. A subsequent search of the vehicle did not reveal any firearms. Officers investigated further to determine the validity of the initial report but it resulted in no actionable evidence to support an arrest.

Officers responded to a residence for a report of a subject violating a court-issued order of protection. Upon arrival, officers located the individual hiding inside the home. The subject was placed in handcuffs and escorted to a waiting patrol vehicle. While being led outside, the subject feigned an inability to breathe before suddenly fleeing on foot. Officers pursued and attempted to stop the subject by deploying their Tasers, but the Taser cartridges were ineffective. After a short chase, officers successfully apprehended the subject. One Taser dart struck the subject in the shoulder. Officers removed the dart on scene and provided basic first aid. The subject was transported and formally charged with Violation of an Order of Protection. No injuries.

Officers responded to a report of an aggravated domestic battery in which the suspect was reported to be in possession of a firearm. Officers located the suspect's vehicle, but the driver refused to stop and fled. After a brief pursuit, the vehicle came to a stop. Officers conducted a high-risk traffic stop, displaying their firearms while taking the suspect into custody to ensure officer safety. A search of the vehicle did not yield a firearm. The suspect was subsequently charged with Aggravated Domestic Battery and Aggravated Fleeing and Eluding.
