**\*A critical element of professional policing is ensuring the response to resistance we use is appropriate, legal, within policy, reviewed for improvement and enhanced training and supervised. Below is an abbreviated summary of the instances of our response to resistance to arrest:**

Officers responded to a residence following a report of a vehicle being driven erratically. Upon arrival, officers observed the vehicle pull into a driveway in an erratic manner. During the initial contact, the suspect was non-compliant. Due to the suspect's history of weapons use, officers attempted a pat-down search, which the suspect physically resisted by pulling away and flailing his arms. The suspect ignored commands to stop and was subsequently pushed against a patrol vehicle to facilitate restraint. With the assistance of a supervisor, the suspect was secured. The suspect sustained a minor laceration to his hand during the encounter and was provided medical supplies at the police department. The suspect refused to provide a statement and was charged with Driving Under the Influence, Resisting Arrest, and Obstructing a Peace Officer.

Officers responded to a residence regarding an individual who was reportedly armed and threatening other occupants. Upon arrival, two subjects were secured outside the residence at gunpoint. One subject was initially non-compliant and made provocative statements toward officers, but was eventually handcuffed without physical resistance. A search of the subjects revealed the aggressor was not armed at the time police made contact with him. During a search of the property, a firearm was located hidden inside a garage; however, witnesses could not definitively identify it as the weapon used during the earlier encounter. The aggressor was arrested and charged with Aggravated Assault and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

Officers responded to a shopping center regarding a report of a subject loading a firearm inside a vehicle. Upon arrival, officers located the occupied vehicle and initiated a high-risk stop, deploying a department-issued rifle and handguns. The suspect complied with verbal commands, exited the vehicle, and was secured in handcuffs. A search of the person and vehicle revealed an AR-style BB gun located in the cargo area; no functional firearms were discovered. The suspect's mother arrived on scene and took possession of the BB gun. The suspect was released from the scene without incident or charges.

Officers responded to a traffic crash where the driver had fled on foot. Upon arrival, a high-risk stop was initiated on the involved vehicle, which remained occupied by a passenger. The passenger complied with verbal commands but lost his footing while walking backward toward officers; he was secured on the ground and handcuffed without injury. The driver was subsequently located and apprehended without incident.

Officers initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle, during which the driver abruptly attempted to exit. An officer drew his handgun and ordered the driver to remain inside while awaiting backup. Upon the arrival of a second officer, the suspect was removed from the vehicle at gunpoint and secured without incident. The driver was found to be intoxicated with children present in the vehicle and was subsequently charged with Driving Under the Influence with a Child.
