*A critical element of professional policing is ensuring the response to resistance we use is appropriate, legal, within policy, reviewed for improvement and improved training and supervised. Below is an abbreviated summary of the instances of our response to resistance to arrest:

An officer conducted a traffic stop of a subject who did not have a driver's license. He was asked to step out of the vehicle but refused. He was told he was under arrest but continued to refuse. Officers ultimately convinced him to exit the vehicle but he attempted to pull away from officers during the handcuffing and search. He had to be held down on the vehicle while the search was conducted. No injuries to officers or the suspect.

The officer responded to the area of a reported aggravated domestic battery, where the victim reported she was stabbed by a suspect with a knife. Officers arrived in the area and observed a subject matching the exact

description provided by the victim, in the same area and walking between a business and residence. Because of the violent nature of the stabbing the officer pointed his firearm at the subject, gave verbal commands and detained him. It was revealed that the subject was uninvolved and was immediately released. The suspect was located and taken into custody several minutes later.

Officers responded to the Metrolink to assist St. Clair County Deputies with a physically resisting subject. The officer assisted deputies by controlling a subject's legs during handcuffing. The subject suffered from mental health issues and was reported missing from a mental health facility in Texas. No injuries to the officer or the suspect.
