*A critical element of professional policing is ensuring the response to resistance we use is appropriate, legal, within policy, reviewed for improvement and enhanced training and supervised. Below is an abbreviated summary of the instances of our response to resistance to arrest:

Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle, Lincoln Trail at Bunkum Road. He found one of the passengers had active warrants. Upon requesting he exit the vehicle; the passenger began to reach beneath the seat while ignoring the officer's commands to stop. The cover officer on scene removed his department-issued Taser from the holster (but did not use it) and instructed the subject to comply. The subject complied and was removed from the vehicle without incident.

Officers attempted to stop a vehicle for excessive speed. Upon activating their emergency lights, the vehicle continued without reducing its speed to an address on Fairfield Drive. The driver exited the vehicle and attempted to enter the residence. Officers quickly contacted the subject while displaying a department-issued Taser (but did not use it). Officers gave the subject commands and he became compliant. The subject was taken into custody without incident.
